Our programs are focused on direct patient care and healthcare administration, including Dental Assisting, Dental Hygiene, Healthcare Management, Health Information Management, Medical Assisting, Medical Office Administration, Medical Billing and Insurance Coding, Massage Therapy, Nursing (including MSN), Occupational Therapy Assisting, Physical Therapist Assistant, Surgical Technology, Medical Lab Technician, and Radiologic Technology. Most programs prepare graduates for industry-specialized certifications.
